Dear Parents and Carers

I have been talking with students recently and we have been looking at ways to further improve behaviour and attendance here at Rise Carr College. One thing above all students say they would like more than ANYTHING else is to be allowed offsite during Lunchtime like many of their peers in Darlington who attend alternative courses.

Having had many discussion and debates with individual and groups of students about responsible behaviour and talks with other colleagues in the authority we would like to propose a trial starting after half term.

Students may earn a lunchtime pass for the day as a result of good conduct this means

- They arrive on time
- Dressed according to dress code
- Complete the learning they have been set
- Respect people – keep hands, feet and personal comments to yourself
- Respect property – follow classroom rules for Health and Safety
- Eat and drink at appropriate times and places
- Switch off phone and/or personal music players during learning time

If good conduct continues then a weekly pass may be issued.

If at anytime when out of school students behave in a way which is anti social, puts themselves or others at risk or they are late back then the pass will be removed until a time when they may be trusted again.

NB All students leaving the site with their pass MUST sign in and out
